Commission Meeting Minutes – January 24, 2023

The Dale County Commission convened in a regular session Tuesday, January 24, 2023. The following members were present: Chairman Steve McKinnon; District One Commissioner Chris Carroll; Two Commissioner Donald O. Grantham; District Three Commissioner Adam Enfinger; and District Four Commissioner Frankie Wilson.

Prepares revisions of property appraisals and estimates market values. Interviews property owners to explain property appraisal methods and techniques.
